

Armourers and Brasiers 700th anniversary conference in association with the Arms and Armour Society 17-18 October 2022

The Armourers and Brasiers Company of London celebrates its 700th anniversary in 2022 and this international conference is part of their commemorations to mark this auspicious occasion. Held in association with the Arms and Armour Society, this 2-day event, with speakers from around the World, will take place at Armourers Hall in London.

Speakers will include (other speakers to be announced):

- Arthur Bijl: A late 15th century dagger in its Timurid court context
- Ruth Brown: The Armourers' Company in the 16th century
- Keith Downen: 'Two hundred potts with three barres English': The 17th century English harquebusier helmet
- Michał Dzięwulski: In search of the non-existent: Uncertainties and mysteries in the iconography of Polish arms and armour in the 17th and 18th centuries.
- Simon Metcalf: A drawing of the right gauntlet from a lost armour of Henry VIII and field notes about the work of Greenwich Armourers on other Royal Armours
- Thom Richardson: Mail and plate armour in the 14th century
- Kay Smith: The London gunfounders of the 16th century
- Michael Spencer: The wit of man went beyond itself: Some English Firearms of the 16th century.
- Guy Wilson: Provincial armourers: a case study of the armour and weapon makers of the Yorkshire town of Ripon.

Costs will be £120 which includes lunches and an evening dinner held in the magnificent Livery Hall of the Armourers' Company
